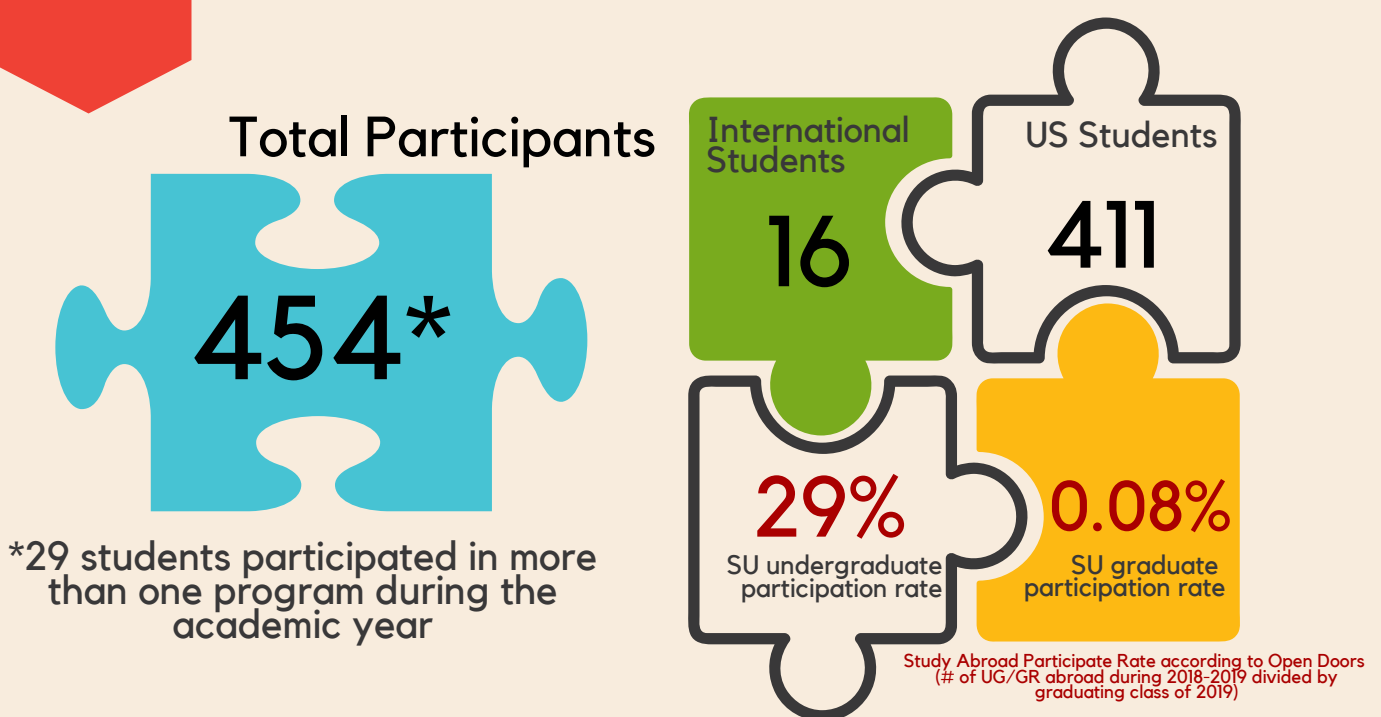

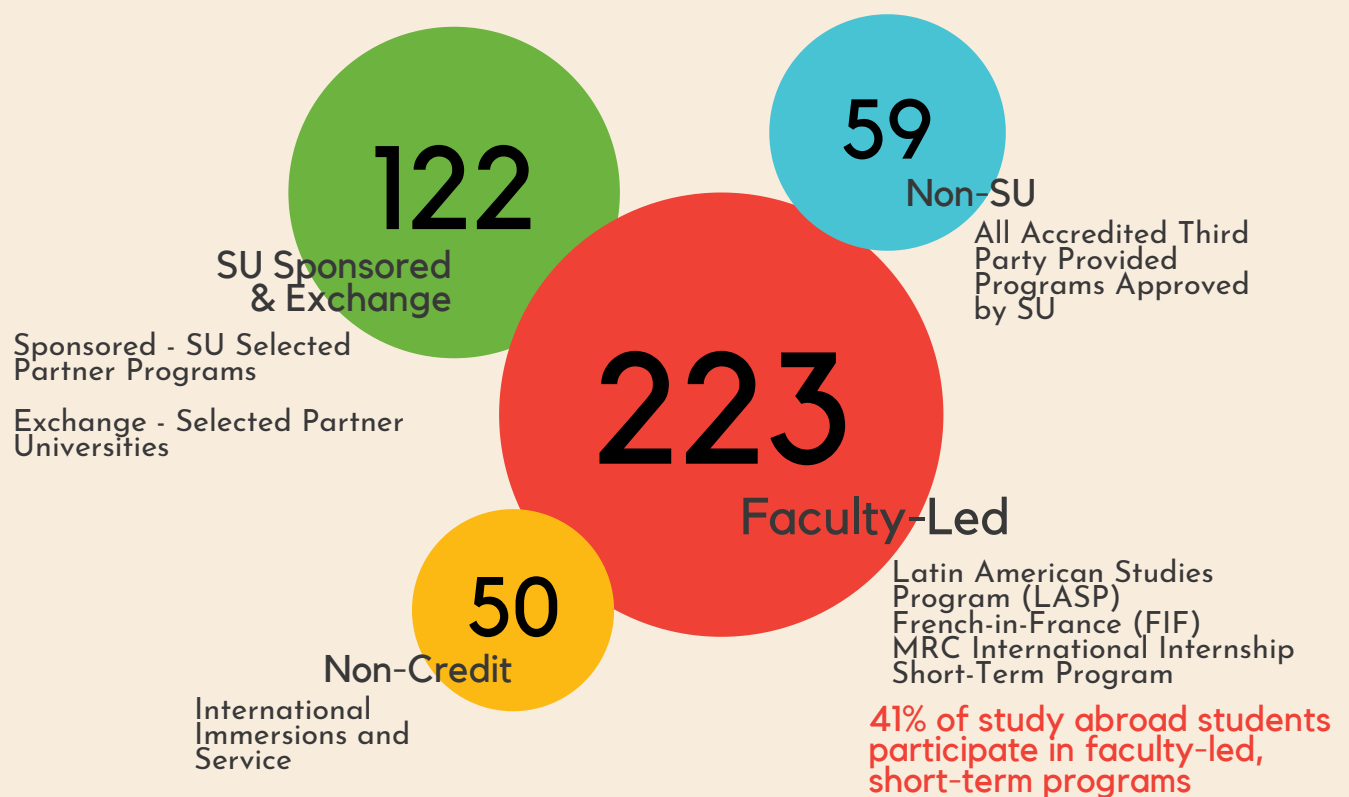

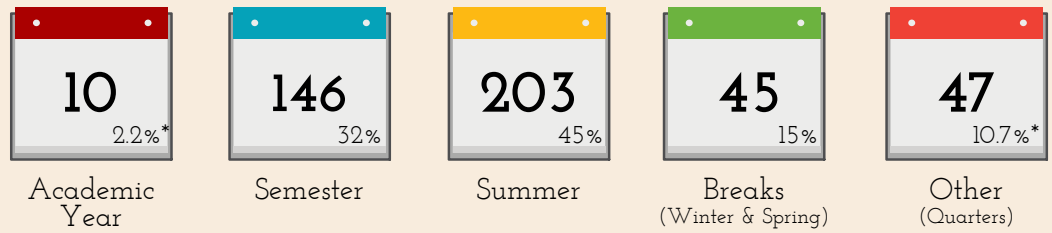


Seattle University students participated in international study, internships & volunteer programs in 43 countries

By Term

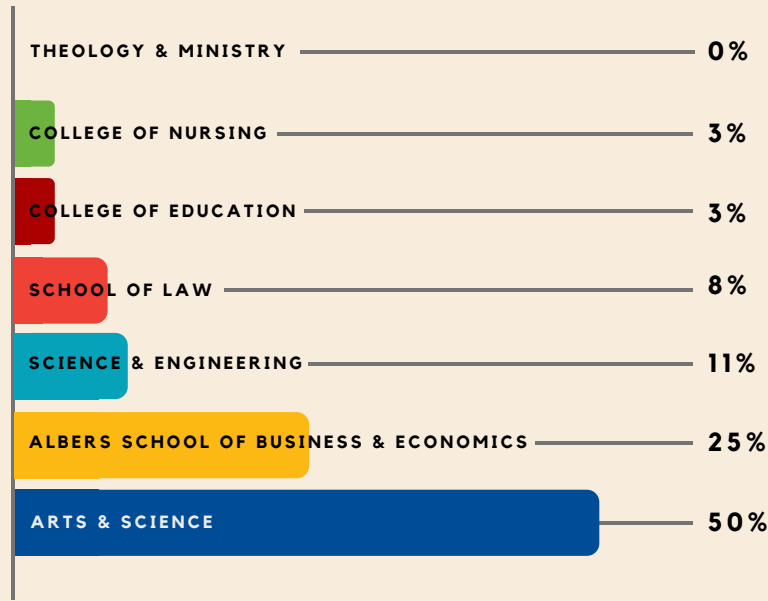

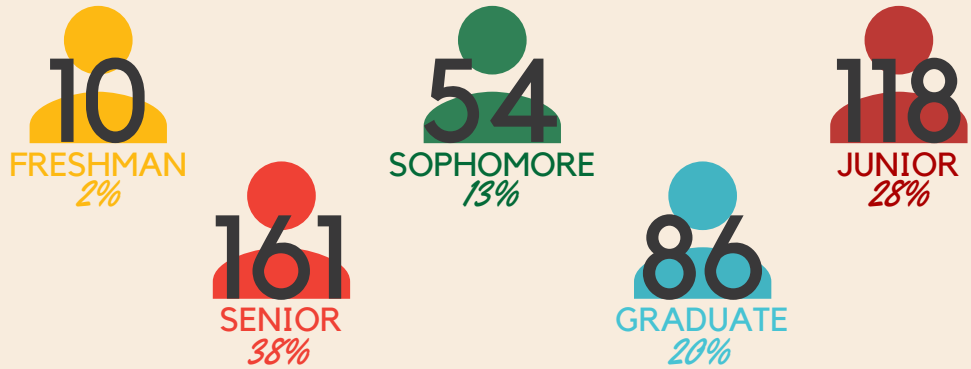
By College

52% of students that went abroad during the academic year 2018-2019 were from the College of Arts & Sciences, which includes the newly incorporated Matteo Ricci Institute.

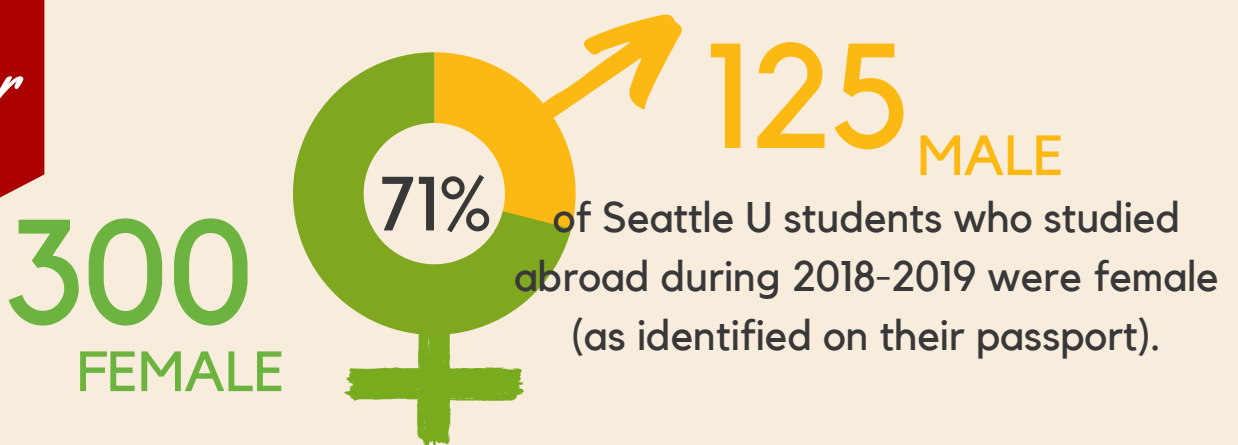


The chart above includes double majors.
